School and Education

An Old Girl who has promoted and advanced education at the College and in the broader community; as well as making Alumni aware of the activities and achievements of the College, and to foster among them an active interest in the welfare of the College.

Health and Community Wellbeing

An Old Girl who has enhanced health and wellbeing in their community.

Arts, Culture, Heritage, and the Environment

An Old Girl who has promoted awareness of and enhancement of the arts, culture and environmental issues in the public arena.

Business and Public Service

An Old Girl who has been a role model to other young women through their role in business or the public sector.



Nomination Process:

Nominations of Old Girls are invited for each of the above categories by responding, in writing, to the following:

1. Please detail name, school years (if and Old Girl yourself), email address and phone number for:
 - a. Yourself and,
 - b. Your nominee.Please include the category you are nominating them in.
2. Please describe and provide evidence of the nominee's involvement in, commitment to, and achievement within their category.
3. Please describe how your nominee exemplifies '**Luce Veritatis : By The Light Of Truth**'. Please also include any information about your nominee's involvement with the College or QMCOGA since leaving school.

Submission and Decision Making Process:

The QMCOGA Committee will receive and assess all applications received. Assessment criteria will be equally weighted and are as follows:

- Involvement, commitment, and achievement within their nominated category.
- Commitment to and demonstration of Queen Margaret College's school motto 'Luce Veritatis : By The Light Of Truth'.
